#### **BEFORE THE GAME**

• **Apparel** – Ensure that the following officials are wearing the correct attire.

- First Aid Confirm that the First Aid officer for your team is present, as well as a stretcher in place.
- Exclusion Zone Ensure that there is a clearly identified exclusion zone set up and parents are aware of expectations.
- Umpires Introduce yourself to all Umpires and be prepared to escort them onto the playing field.
- Officials Ensure that the only the following officials are inside the exclusion zone.

• Ground Marshall – Take position outside of the exclusion zone prior to the commencement of the match.

### **DURING THE GAME**

- Behaviour Monitor spectators and exclusion zone for any breaches of Code of Conduct and act accordingly.
- **Umpires** Be visible and ready should the umpires require your assistance.
- **Red Cards** Assist the Team Manager in escorting any red carded player from the playing field for the remainder of the game.
- **First Aid** In the event of an injury work with the First Aid Officer to coordinate any contacting of emergency services if required.

#### **AFTER THE GAME**

- **Umpires** At the completion of the match, escort umpires from the playing surface.
- Ground Marshall Incident Form Should there be anything that you need to report to the SANFL, please complete and submit the Ground Marshall Match Day Incident Form.

The Ground Marshall role plays a pivotal role in the quality management of the match day environments within each match of the National Pharmacies SANFL Juniors Competition. Please ensure that, as Ground Marshall, you reflect the positive aspects of the Code of Conduct and provide a proactive service to participate on Game Day.
